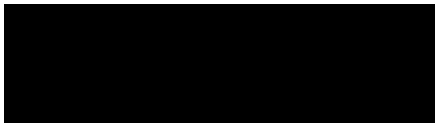
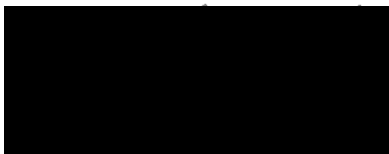
4136 We came to Loxley House to see the plans for the Nottingham City Local

I hope the information below helps with your site queries;

- The work being carried out at the Queen's Medical car park, at the corner of Abbey Street and Clifton Boulevard, is part of the City Council's Western Cycle Corridor project. Information on this can be found in the enclosed leaflet. This is not the location for the approved helipad.
- The former Red Cross site, on the corner of Abbey Bridge and Gregory Street, is no longer in City Council ownership. However, there has been no recent planning activity on the site.
- There are currently no applications on the site of the former Red Cow public house.
