

item	disposal	Look for these images
Asbestos	Please ring 0115 915 2000 for advice on how to dispose of sheets of asbestos.	
Animal beddings	Please put in green wheelie bin for rubbish.	
Animal droppings	Please put in green wheelie bin for rubbish.	
Aluminium	Can be placed in the non-ferrous metal container at your local HWRC.	
Bathroom items	If you deliver in small car or van. Redfield Road only.	household waste scrap metal
Batteries	Household batteries can be recycled at all of the household waste recycling centres in Nottingham. Each site has a designated bin where all batteries should be placed. Can be recycled with your curb side bin in a separate bag.	
Bedding and quilts and pillows and sleeping bags	These can be placed in the textiles bank available at most HWRCs.	
Bricks and rubble	Only a couple of bags and if you deliver in small car or van. A charge is now in place for these. Please refer to the scale for charges.	
Bric-a-brac	If it comes from your house. You will be able to dispose at most HWRCs.	
Cans (aluminium and steel drink and food cans)	You can also empty aluminium and steel drink cans and washed out food tins into your recycling wheeled bin.	
Car batteries	Car batteries can be taken to your local household waste recycling centre for recycling and safe disposal. On arrival, please ask site staff who will be able to direct you to the appropriate container.	
Cardboard	Large cardboard boxes and packaging can be recycled at your local HWRC.	
Clothing	Most HWRCs have a clothing and textile bank for recycling and reuse.	
Cooking oil	There is a special container at all recycling centres for used cooking oil from household as it can be recycled for green energy.	
Creosote and other garden chemicals	These can be taken to the Redfield Road site please see the staff on site on arrival.	
Electrical equipment	Electrical equipment can be taken to your local HWRC for recycling and safe disposal.	
Fire extinguisher	These can be taken to the Redfield Road site please see the staff on site on arrival.	
Foil	Accepted in general waste skip.	
Fridge freezers	Fridges and freezers can be taken to your local HWRC for recycling and safe disposal. Please ask a member of staff on arrival at the site about where to place the item.	
Furniture	Furniture can be taken to your local HWRC, where it can be sold on for reuse if in good condition. Please ask a member of staff on arrival at the site about where to place the item.	
Garden waste	Green waste can be taken to your local HWRC. From here it is taken then turned into Soil Conditioner which is used on farm.	
Gas bottles	Empty gas bottles should be returned to local retailer/stockist. Gas bottles that cannot be returned to retailer/stockist can be taken to a recycling centre and handed to site staff. Do not place gas bottle in your wheelie bin as they're potentially explosive.

Glass bottles and jars	All HWRCs have a bottle bank onsite.	mixed glass bottles & jars
Glass (flat)	If it is a small amount and comes from your home and delivered in a car or small van. Redfield Road only. We cannot take commercial or business rubbish.	
Household chemicals	These can be taken to the Redfield Road site please see the staff on site on arrival.	
insulation	If it is a small amount and comes from your house and delivered in small car or van (must be double bagged and contain no asbestos). Redfield road only. We cannot take commercial or business rubbish.	
Kitchen cupboard/units	If it comes from house and is delivered by small van or car. Redfield Road only. We cannot take commercial or business rubbish.	wood & timber
Light bulbs	Energy efficient light bulbs and fluorescent tubes can be recycled at your local HWRC.	fluorescent tubes
Mattress	Mattresses can be taken to your local HWRC for disposal. Place in the container for non-recyclable waste.	
Mobile phones	Mobile phones can be taken to your local HWRC for recycling.	electrical
Oils (used from cars)	If it comes from your own car it can be recycled at your local HWRC. Cannot take oil from businesses.	used engine oil
Paint tins	These can be taken to the Redfield Road site please see the staff on site on arrival.	
Plasterboard	Small quantities and if it comes from your house and is delivered in small van or car. Redfield Road only. If you have large quantities you will need to hire a skip. Please call skip hire on 0115 915 2111	
Plastic bags	You can empty plastic bags in your general waste bin.	
Plastic bottles	You can empty plastic bottles into your recycled wheeled bin.	plastic bottles
Scrap metal	Unwanted metal items from your household can be recycled at any HWRC in Nottingham.	scrap metal
Soil	Only a couple of bags and if it comes from your own garden and is delivered in a car or small van. If you have large quantities you will need to hire a skip. Please call skip hire on 0115 915 2111.	hardcore & rubble garden waste
Textiles	Most HWRCs have a clothing/textile and shoe bank for recycling and reuse. Includes all clothing, linen, curtains, shoes and other household textiles. Items should be bagged before placing in the bank. Even damaged textiles can be recycled and odd socks are still useful.	mixed textiles & clothes
Tiles	If it comes from your house. Can be recycled at your local HWRC.	household waste
Wallpaper	Large amounts of wallpaper from your home can be taken to your local household waste recycling centre (HWRC) for disposal.	mixed paper & card
Washing machine	Can be recycled at your local HWRC.	electrical
Windows	If they come from your house and are delivered in car or small van. Redfield road only. We cannot take commercial or business waste.	
Wood	Treated, untreated and mixed wood can be reused or recycled at your local HWRC. Bulky items such as furniture can be sold in the on-site sales area for reuse.	wood & timber
