These free workshops provide a brief introduction to the Signs of Safety approach to assessment and planning for a multi-agency audience who do not have access to more extensive training.

## Aim

To provide colleagues with an introduction to the Signs of Safety approach and explore how it is being used in Safeguarding practice in Nottingham City.

## Learning outcomes

- Understand the Signs of Safety approach
- Consider how this approach can be used to involve parents, children and young people in assessments and planning
- Examine how judgements based on a balance of information regarding concerns and safety can be evidenced and improved
- Identify the benefits of using this model in multi-disciplinary work and with partnership agencies
